Above: These two simple suns are clay (unfired=not baked). The rest have been fired in a kiln so they are bisque ware.

Above: These painted ones have been painted with either watercolor or acrylic. None here are glazed which requires another firing in the kiln. There are so many ways to make Slab Suns. These are just a few examples. Use your imagination and create your own style and design.
